Re: Voluntary Stage 1 Water Conservation Alert

Due to sporadic mechanical issues with Well #3 and high water usage, the Kawela Plantation Water System that serves Kawela Plantation Homeowners Association is enacting a Stage 1 Water Conservation Alert effective immediately. Should a Stage 1 Alert (voluntary) not be sufficient to protect the water storage, a Stage 2 Water Conservation Alert (mandatory) will be issued.

- This notice affects **all Units**
- **We are requesting the following:**
 - **Even numbered lots irrigate on Monday, Wednesday, and Friday**
 - **Odd numbered lots irrigate on Tuesday, Thursday, Saturday**
- Limit lawn watering to that necessary for plant survival. Water Lawns between 10:00 p.m. to 4:00 a.m.
- Water shrubbery the minimum amount required. Water shrubs before the peak demand hours of 6:00 a.m. or after 10:00 p.m.

During a declared Stage 1 water conservation alert, the following voluntary water conservation practices are encouraged:

- Inspect and repair all faulty and defective parts of faucets and toilets.
- Use shower for bathing rather than bathtub and limit shower to no more than five minutes.
- Do not leave faucets running while shaving, brushing teeth, rinsing or preparing food.
- Limit the use of clothes washers and dishwashers and when used, operate fully loaded.
- Operate dishwashers during non-peak demand hours of 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
- Limit vehicle washing.
- Do not wash down outside areas such as sidewalks, driveways, patios, etc.
- Install water saving shower heads and other devices.
- Use disposable and biodegradable dishes where possible.
- Install water saving devices in toilets such as early closing flappers.
- Limit hours of water-cooled air conditioners.
- Do not fill swimming or wading pools.
